Rules for Using the Field House

Welcome to Creasey Mahan Nature Preserve! We are a public charity and appreciate your consideration in following these guidelines to keep costs down and help maintain the Field House. We hope you enjoy your experience. Please respect the Preserve and **"leave no trace."**

FIELD HOUSE GUIDELINES:

- Use quick release painter's tape or 3M type removable strips for hanging of decorations or presentation charts and applying anything to the flooring. **DO NOT USE SCOTCH TAPE, DUCT TAPE or TACKS/PUSH PINS** or your damage deposit will not be returned.
- Note that you have been provided with a recycle container (blue or a blue trash bin with a yellow lid) for all plastic bottles, cans and paper items. All plates and items with food on them must go in the trash bin, **NOT** the recycle bin.
- Please empty bathroom trash cans into the main trash bag and then deposit all trash in the large blue dumpster located in the corner of the Nature Center parking lot. Also, follow the cleaning instructions that are posted on the refrigerator to receive your full refund of the cleaning/damage deposit.
- Please use the cleaning items provided in the small closet near the bathrooms to clean-up after your rental. This is how we keep our prices low. If you do not clean, then you will forfeit your cleaning/damage deposit.
- In addition to the restrooms in the Field House, there are public restrooms outside in the "barn" or maintenance building. Look for the signs and the two green doors. These are open from dawn to dusk every day. If you are camping, the restrooms will remain open overnight.
- If you are camping, using the fire pit and/or the Field House, please do your best to ensure that the public restrooms are kept tidy and free of trash. Toilet paper is provided, and extras are in the cabinets. If you run out, please call or text Caretaker Kathryn Keefe 619-2398.

GENERAL RULES FOR GROUNDS: *Please –*

- No loud music! This is a wildlife refuge, and it disturbs animals and visitors.
- No skateboarding, no ATV's and no dirt bikes allowed anywhere on the Preserve.
- No bicycles, motorized bikes, golf carts or vehicles on grass or on trails. Bikes and vehicles are allowed on paved areas only. Bike racks are provided.
- No paintball guns, air soft guns, or guns of any kind are allowed at any time. Needless to say, no hunting is ever allowed.
- No collecting of frogs, tadpoles, turtles, or any animals of any kind. No collecting of plants or trees.
